BIJAGUA DE UPALA

Celeste Mountain Lodge is a renowned eco-lodge located in the northern highlands of Costa Rica. It is celebrated for its "bioclimatic" architecture, sustainable philosophy, and "Tica-Fusion" cuisine. The lodge is perched on a ridge, offering panoramic views of both the Tenorio and Miravalles volcanoes.

Location & Environment

Region:

Bijagua de Upala, Guanacaste/Alajuela border, Costa Rica.

Setting:

Situated on a 7-hectare property (3 hectares of open space and 4 hectares of protected primary rainforest).

Climate: Refreshing mountain climate (approx. 18°C–30°C / 64°F–86°F) with steady breezes.

Proximity: * 4 km (2.5 miles) from the village of Bijagua. 6 km (3.7 miles) from the entrance of Tenorio Volcano National Park (home of the famous Río Celeste).



Accommodations

The lodge features 18 minimalist, "eco-design" rooms in a single two-story building.

Room Size: All rooms are approximately 27 m² (290 sq. ft.).

Views: Every room is southwest-facing with floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking the rainforest and volcanoes.

Amenities:

Private bathroom with hot water and hairdryer.

Small fridge and in-room safe.

WiFi access.

Unique furniture made from recycled materials.

Accessibility: One room is specifically equipped for guests with disabilities.

Activities & Facilities

The Celeste Trail: A private 1.7 km (1.1 mile) hiking trail through primary forest located directly on the property. Great for spotting monkeys, toucans, and rare birds.

Wildlife Watching: The gardens are specifically designed to attract hummingbirds and butterflies.

Common Areas: * Large lounge with "covered gardens" (indoor/outdoor integration).

Panoramic terrace and bar.

Tours (Available through the lodge):

Guided night tours on the property.

Río Celeste / Tenorio Volcano National Park hikes.

Horseback riding and chocolate tours.

Tubing or rafting on local rivers.
